## HOW TO APPLY

**DEADLINE OF APPLICATION: APRIL 14, 2021**

Interested University College students can indicate their choice to follow courses at EUC by submitting the Inter UC Exchange application form to the international office of their home college by Wednesday April 14. Please note that students who opt for a full semester at EUC will get priority.

Tuition fees or other (administrative) fees do not apply. Possible extra costs incurred through this exchange are the student's responsibility. There are no scholarships attached to this exchange.

## GOOD TO KNOW

### PROBLEM BASED LEARNING

Many courses at Erasmus University College are taught following the Problem Based Learning (PBL) method. PBL is a method of education in which the students are at the centre and the teacher is the guide-on-the-side. Classes are constructed as following:

- Small tutorial groups (10-12 students)
- Real-life or academic problems (cases) as the starting point of learning process
- Discussions and analysis under guidance of a tutor
- Questions from analysis will be used as a guide for self-study (from handbooks and articles)
- Students report back in the next tutorial meeting and discuss findings with other students and tutor

Assessment is consisting of assignments (presentations, essays) and exams.

### INTRODUCTION PROGRAMME

The EUC Introduction Programme (Monday 23 - Wednesday 25 August) provides useful information about settling into Rotterdam, EUC's education systems, and our Problem-Based Learning methodology.
